Notice of hearing

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 08.30am on 21 & 22 August 2024. It will be held remotely but based at the ACCA's Offices, The Adelphi, 1-11 John Adam Street, London, WC2N 6AU.

The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wish to attend. However, ACCA is only able to accommodate remote access to the hearing. Please contact <u>adminadjudication@accaglobal.com</u> to obtain information about attending this (or any other) hearing.

The case to be heard on this day concerns Mr Amol Samant .

Allegations

- 1) Mr Amol Samant, an ACCA student, sent emails to ACCA on one or more of the following dates:
 - a) 02 December 2020;
 - b) 03 December 2020;
 - c) 18 July 2022;
 - d) 31 July 2022

and, offered to make payments of £200, and or £500, to ACCA to enable him to obtain a pass mark in ACCA's Advanced Audit and Assurance ("AAA Exam"), and Advanced Performance Management exams ("APM Exam").

- 2) Mr Samant's conduct at allegations 1a d, above was:
 - a) dishonest in that the offering of such payments amounted to an attempt to bribe ACCA staff.

- 3) On one or more of the following dates, Mr Samant sent emails to ACCA in which he used grossly offensive language:
 - a) 14 May 2022;
 - b) 09 August 2022.
- 4) By reason of any or all of allegations 1 to 3 above Mr Samant is:
 - a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i).

The allegations listed above are current at the date of publication.

The case will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
