#### Notice of hearing

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 08.00am on 03 December 2024. It will be held remotely but based at the ACCA's Offices, The Adelphi, 1-11 John Adam Street, London, WC2N 6AU.

The case to be heard on this day concerns Mr Haisheng Hu.

#### Allegations

#### Allegation 1

- (a) On or around 08 February 2021 and 08 March 2021, Mr Haisheng Hu submitted or caused to be submitted to ACCA the documents listed in Schedule A all or any of which purported to have been issued by the James Cook University when in fact they had not;
- (b) Mr Haisheng Hu's conduct as set out in paragraph 1(a) above was:
  - Dishonest in that Mr Haisheng Hu knew that any or all the documents referred to at 1(a) above were false and were submitted in order to gain exam exemptions to which he was not entitled or in the alternative by his conduct in the above respect
  - ii) Failed to demonstrate Integrity
- By reason of his conduct in relation to any or all of the matters set out at 1(a) 1(b) above Mr Haisheng
  Hu is:

i) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to Byelaw 8(a)(i)

The allegations listed above are current at the date of publication.

The case will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
