Notice of hearing

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 08.30am on 18 July 2024. It will be held remotely but based at the ACCA's Offices, The Adelphi, 1-11 John Adam Street, London, WC2N 6AU.

The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wish to attend. However, ACCA is only able to accommodate remote access to the hearing. Please contact <u>adminadjudication@accaglobal.com</u> to obtain information about attending this (or any other) hearing.

The case to be heard on this day concerns Mr Muhammad Hammad Hassan.

Allegations

Mr Muhammad Hammad Hassan ('Mr Hassan'), a student member of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants ('ACCA'):

- Contrary to Paragraph 3(1) of the Complaints and Disciplinary Regulations 2021, Mr Hassan has failed to co-operate fully with the investigation of a complaint, arising out of his conduct during an on-demand MA1 Management Information examination, in that he failed to respond fully or at all to any or all of ACCA's correspondence sent on:
 - (a) 04 May 2021
 - (b) 18 June 2021
 - (c) 08 July 2021
- 2. On 08 February 2021 before and during a scheduled MA1 Management Information examination Mr Hassan:

- (a) Failed to ensure he was in a room without distractions and not disturbed by anyone, in breach of Regulation 1 and the Examination Guidelines (as applicable in 2021);
- (b) Had an item not permitted at his desk or about his person contrary to Examination Regulation 1 and the Examination Guidelines (as applicable in 2021).
- 3. By reason of his conduct, Mr Hassan is:
 - Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i), in respect of any or all of the matters set out at Allegations 1 to 2 above; or, in the alternative,
 - (b) Liable to disciplinary action pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(iii), in respect of any or all of the matters set out above.

The allegations listed above are current at the date of publication.

The case will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
