Disciplinary Committee ordered student removed/*

On 30 May 2024, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following amended allegations against Mr Muhammad Nouman Jamshaid of Dunya Pur, Punjab, Pakistan:

<u>Allegations</u>

Mr Muhammad Nouman Jamshaid ('Mr Jamshaid') ACCA student on 19 February 2021 and in relation to a scheduled MA2 Managing Costs and Finance computer-based examination (the 'exam'):

- 1. Contrary to Examination Regulation 2, failed to comply with instructions issued by:
 - ACCA personnel as per the "Information Sheet for On-Demand CBE Students sitting exams a) at home" in that case he caused or permitted a third party or parties to be present in the room where he sat the exam and during that exam and thereby failed to ensure he was in a room with no-one else around him:
 - (b) The exam proctor (remote invigilator), in that he failed to respond adequately to an instruction to keep his eyes on his computer screen during the exam.
- 2. Further, Mr Jamshaid's conduct as referred to in Allegation 1(a) above was:
 - Dishonest, in that he deliberately sought to conceal the presence of the third party or parties (a) referred to in allegation 1(a.
- 3. By reason of his conduct Mr Jamshaid is:
 - (a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i), in respect of any or all of the matters set out in Allegation 1 and/or 2 above.

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Mr Muhammad Nouman Jamshaid be removed from the Student Register and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £6000.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's findings and orders by way of a news release, as soon as practicable.

* An order made by the Disciplinary Committee shall take effect from the date of expiry of the Appeal Period referred to in the Appeal Regulations unless the Committee directs that the order should have immediate effect
