Disciplinary Committee ordered student be removed*

On 06 November 2024, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Ms Mwangala Keturah Imenda of Lusaka, Zambia:

Allegations

- 1. On or around 24 April 2023, Ms Mwangala Keturah Imenda an ACCA student asked person A to sit an ACCA exam on her behalf in return for payment,
- 2. Ms Imenda's conduct as referred to in allegation 1:
 - a) was contrary to exam Regulation 10;
 - b) was dishonest in that she was seeking to obtain assistance in her exam attempt in order to gain an unfair advantage by reason of the matters referred to in allegation 1;
- 3. By reason of her conduct, Ms Imenda is liable to disciplinary action pursuant to:
 - a) bye-law 8(a)(i).

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Ms Mwangala Keturah be removed from ACCA Student register and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £6,345.50.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's findings and orders by way of a news release, as soon as practicable.

* An order made by the Disciplinary Committee shall take effect from the date of expiry of the Appeal Period referred to in the Appeal Regulations unless the Committee directs that the order should have immediate effect
