Disciplinary Committee ordered member to be severely reprimanded*

On 19 and 20November 2024, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Mr Federico Lago of London, United Kingdom:

Allegations

Mr Federico Lago, an ACCA member:

- 1. In or around 2018 or 2019, while he was an ACCA student:
 - a. Submitted a CV to Firm A which purported to state that between February 2013 and April 2016, he was an Accounts Manager at Firm B, when in fact, he was a partner at Firm C, details of which were omitted from his CV.
- 2. Mr Lago's conduct was:
 - c. In respect of Allegation 1 a) a failure to act with integrity.
- 3. By reason of his conduct, Mr Lago is guilty of misconduct pursuant to ACCA bye-law 8(a)(i) in respect of any or all the matters set out at Allegations 1 and 2 above.

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Mr Lago be severely reprimanded and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £3000,00.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's findings and orders by way of a news release, as soon as practicable.

* An order made by the Disciplinary Committee shall take effect from the date of expiry of the Appeal Period referred to in the Appeal Regulations unless the Committee directs that the order should have immediate effect.
