Disciplinary Committee ordered student removed

On 13 September 2024, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Ms Taslim Kausar Shaikh of Surat, India:

<u>Allegations</u>

Ms. Taslim Kausar Shaikh, (Ms Shaikh) a student of Association of Chartered Certified Accountants ('ACCA'):

- Contrary to Regulation 3(1) of the Complaints and Disciplinary Regulations 2014 (as amended) Ms. 1. Shaikh failed to co-operate with an investigation of a complaint, in that she did not respond to any or all of ACCA's correspondence dated:
 - (a) 13 April 2021;
 - (b) 06 May 2021;
 - 26 May 2021 (c)
 - 07 June 2021 (d)
- 2. By reason of her conduct in respect of any or all of the matters set out above, Ms Shaikh is:
 - (a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i);

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Ms Taslim Kausar Shaikh be removed from the student registerand to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £6200.00.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's findings and orders by way of a news release, as soon as practicable.

* An order made by the Disciplinary Committee shall take effect from the date of expiry of the Appeal Period referred to in the Appeal Regulations unless the Committee directs that the order should have immediate effect
