Disciplinary Committee ordered no further action*

On 17 January 2025, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved (and by admission) the following allegations against Mr Ajibola Ashimi of London, United Kingdom:

Allegations

Mr Ajibola Ashimi, a student of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants ('ACCA'):

- 1. During a Management Accounting ("MA") examination held on 22 February 2022:
 - a. Was in possession of unauthorised material, namely an ACCA Management Accounting pocket notebook. (the 'Unauthorised Material), contrary to Examination Regulation 4;
- 2. By reason of his conduct, Mr Ashimi is:
 - b. Liable to disciplinary action pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(iii), in respect of Allegation 1.

The Disciplinary Committee ordered no further action and made no award for costs.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's findings and orders by way of a news release, as soon as practicable.

* An order made by the Disciplinary Committee shall take effect from the date of expiry of the Appeal Period referred to in the Appeal Regulations unless the Committee directs that the order should have immediate effect
