Review of actions from last meeting

Items were reviewed and outstanding activities would be progressed where appropriate and reported at the September meeting.

Panel Objectives for 2024/25

The panel agreed to focus on three ACCA themes – AI, Sustainability and Talent. To collaborate and produce sector relevant outputs which will aim to improve Net promoter Scores from the quarterly membership satisfaction surveys.

The group broke into three subgroups for further discussion and planning on the topics. The Chair agreed the whole group would discuss/debate sustainability separately.

Sector trends and insights

- Reduced government funding across the NFP/third sector
- Fundraising slowing down due to cost of living, less disposable income
- Pressure on resources doing more with less
- Demonstrating financial stability to demonstrate any mergers and acquisitions
- Government change causing uncertainty, job cuts and damage to morale across central government
- Risk of redundancies across all the sector but especially in higher education
- Identified 60 universities across the UK going through redundancy programmes
- Student numbers in decline
- Technology being seen as a threat to jobs; keeping up with audit clients and the level of Al adoption e.g. N A Scotland
- The need for people across the sector to be resilient in the face of change
